The winning ninot will get a place in the Fallas museum. The other ninots will be burned at the end of Las Fallas 2020.

00:00 – ‘Nit de L’ albà’ of the fallas in the whole city

With a pyrotechnic spectacle at Plaza Ayuntamiento.

Monday 16th of March

08:00 – ‘La Plantà’ of all Fallas

Las Fallas 2020 has officially started! All the beautiful Fallas are placed in the city. So you better put on your comfortable shoes to stroll around the city to see them all!

14:00 – ‘La Mascletà’ at Plaza Ayuntamiento

16:30 – Award ceremony for the children’s Fallas at Plaza Ayuntamiento

On the stage in front of the town hall (Plaza del Ayuntamiento)

will be held a ceremony to celebrate the winning Ninots.

00:00 – Castillo de Fuegos at Paseo de la Alameda

If you think you saw all the amazing fireworks already, then guess again! Because this one is one of the biggest and most beautiful firework shows of Las Fallas. At Paseo de la Alameda you can see this show. Make sure you arrive on time, it will be crowded but definitely worth the wait!

Tuesday 17th of March

09:00 – Award ceremony at Plaza Ayuntamiento

There will be an award ceremony and a ceremony for the Fallas and the illuminated streets.

14:00 – ‘La Mascletà’ at Plaza Ayuntamiento

15:30 – ‘La Ofrenda’ op Plaza de Virgen

This is a must-see. This is first day of the floral offering. Every Fallas group will bring a floral offering to the Virgen at the end of a long and emotional procession. This might be the most impressive and emotional moment of Las Fallas 2020. (from 15:30 to around 23.00)

01:00 – ‘Castillo de Fuegos’ at Paseo de la Alameda

Fireworks display at Paseo de Alameda.

Wednesday 18th of March

14:00 – ‘La Mascletà’ at Plaza Ayuntamiento

15:30 – ‘La Ofrenda’ day two at Plaza de Virgen

01:30 – ‘NIT DEL FOC’ at Paseo de la Alameda

The biggest and most important firework show of Las Fallas 2020. This might be the most extensive and spectacular firework show you will ever see!

Thursday 19th of March

14:00 – ‘La Mascletà’ at Plaza Ayuntamiento

22:00 – ‘Crema’ of the children’s Fallas

22:30 – ‘Crema’ of the winning children’s Falla

The award-winning children’s Falla, or Ninot, will be set on fire separately. The Ninot (the top of the Falla) will be removed before and brought to the Fallas museum.

23:00 – ‘Crema’ of the children’s Falla at Plaza del Ayuntamiento

The children’s Falla at Plaza Ayuntamiento is the last children’s Falla to be set on fire.

00:00 – ‘Cremà’ of all fallas in Valencia

The award winning Falla, or Ninot, will be set on fire separately. The Ninot (the top of the Falla) will be removed before and brought to the Fallas museum.

00:30 – ‘Cremà’ of the winning Falla

“Cremà” of the Falla who won the first prize in the special section.

01:00 – ‘Cremà’ of the Falla at Plaza del Ayuntamiento

This Falla will be set on fire with an introducing firework show.
